Dear FSE Families,

We had a busy week of many activities to highlight Bullying Awareness Week. One of the activities allowed students to participate in the 'wrinkled heart activity' whereby each was given a piece of heart shaped paper and a discussion occurred around how hurtful actions or words can cause our hearts to be hurt or 'wrinkled'. The students then wrinkled their paper heart to demonstrate the impact of bullying behaviour. Next, students were asked to uncrumple their 'wrinkled hearts' and smooth them out again. Obviously, the paper was not able to be the same as it was before being 'wrinkled'. This symbolizes the fact that even when we apologize our actions and words have a lasting impact on others. The activity concluded with students brainstorming ways in which they could prevent the 'wrinkling of the heart'. Here are some of the ideas:

- Treating others how you want to be treated
- Using respectful, kind words to solve problems
- Sharing with each other and taking turns
